



SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION INDICATORS: TRENDS AND CHALLENGES

(Moscow, Russia, 18-20 September 2007)

PROGRAMME

I. Background

UNESCO Institute for Statistics (UIS), with the collaboration of SC/PDS (Division of Science Policy and Sustainable Development), has recently designed and implemented a worldwide consultation on science and technology statistics and indicators. Both are also engaged in capacity building activities regarding S&T indicators. There are quite valuable institutional experiences in Moscow UNESCO Office cluster countries regarding science, technology and innovation policy-relevant indicators (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, the Republic of Moldova and the Russian Federation). Important issues for those countries could be analyzed, particularly concerning incremental innovation processes and the need to link S&T data and policy to major economic policies.

II. Objectives

- a. Analyze recent international experiences and trends regarding science, technology and innovation policy-relevant indicators
- b. Training of high-level technical staff from S&T policy bodies and universities in Moscow UNESCO Office cluster countries
- c. Increase the number of countries regularly producing quality S&T indicators in Moscow UNESCO Office cluster countries
- d. Strengthen local capacities for the production of such indicators, with the final aim of establishing sustainable local S&T statistics systems
- e. Promote the use of S&T indicators to support evidence-based S&T policy making.
- f. Share experiences with other developing countries in the field of S&T indicators, and to address the problems that countries may have encountered in collecting S&T statistics
- g. Generate initiatives related to good practices that might be relevant in other countries of the region
